He also helped revive GreenPrint, the city's dormant sustainability plan and advocated for the hiring of a sustainability coordinator to oversee that plan.

He is vice president of Keep Pinellas Beautiful and president of Spring Branch Neighborhood Association, where he worked with

the city to recognize and invest in State Street Park, a nearly 9-acre oasis of undeveloped greenspace. Leone has helped organize and participate in neighborhood cleanups that were instrumental in the removal of more than 5,000 pounds of trash from the neighborhood in the last four years.
